



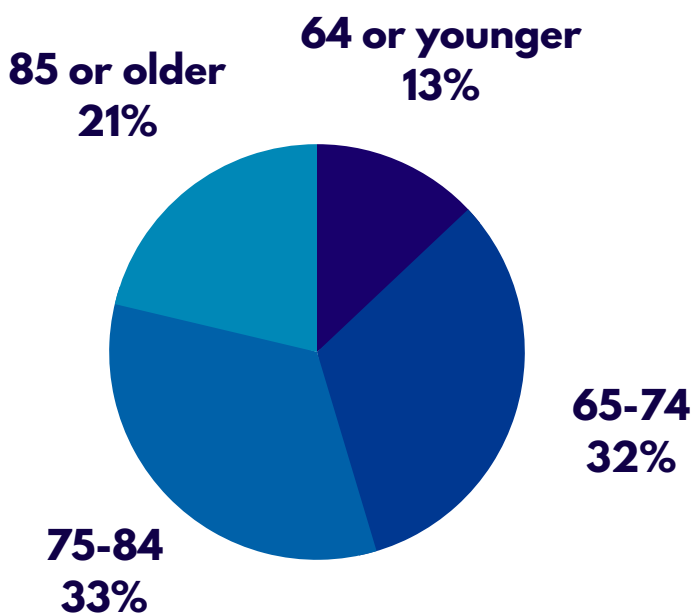

"Villages are a relatively new, consumer-directed model that brings together older adults in a neighborhood or community who have a mutual interest in aging in place."



Services provided:

- Hosting social events
- Transportation services
- Classes/Educational events
- Companionship
- Technology assistance
- Home repair/maintenance



Villages regularly do work to "help or impact the larger community."

This includes advocating for changes in community programs or services for older adults, as well as advocating for changes in public policies for older adults.

Villages are typically funded through a variety of sources. On average, 44% of village revenue comes from membership dues, **22% comes from individual donations**, 12% of revenue comes from private foundation grants, 9% of revenue comes from fundraising events, 6% from business or corporate donations, and 5% from government grants/contacts.
