

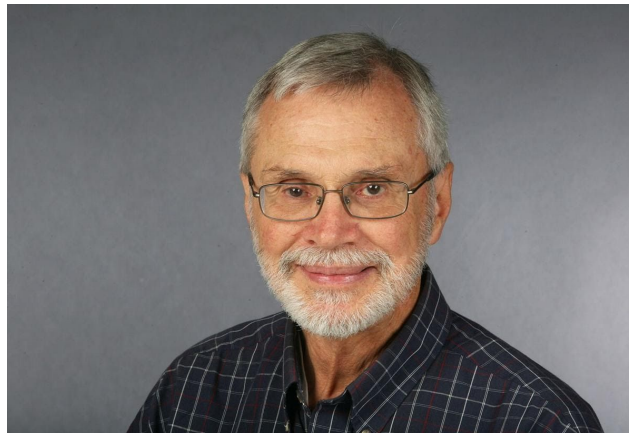

The Board of the HVNA met last week and considered 2 zoning requests:

1. 295 Calhoun St at the corner of Halsey Blvd. A developer plans a 7-8 story apt bldg. They plan upgrades to the boardwalk around Long Lake. The BAR appearance has been deferred.
2. 80 Ashley Ave at the corner of Wentworth St. A couple bought the site and planned a garden shop and cafe based on a European model. They planned to keep the buildings. Several neighbors opposed the project and the board feels it is too intense in its current plan. The owners may redo the plans.
