COVID Survey Results:

Thanks to all who participated in our survey last month about life during the pandemic. Here's what we learned: 80% of respondents have been very concerned about the pandemic in general; 86% are somewhat or very concerned about the impact on their personal health, safety and wellbeing; 90% have participated in an online activity; and the top 3 challenges are not being able to visit family/friends (67%), general anxiety about the impact of Covid in my life (29%), and finding safe ways to exercise (24%). The board is also considering suggestions that respondents offered for future programs and activities.
